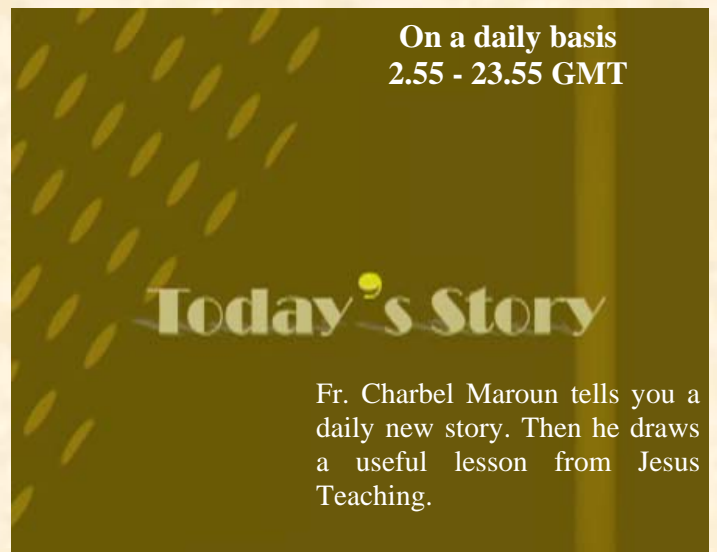

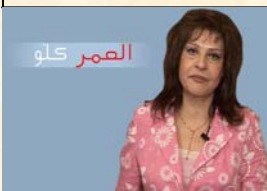

## Saints from all over the World



### A brief about the life of the Blessed Nun

**Jeanne Emilie** was born on 9/3/1811. She lost her mother and sister in **Castres** where she grew up. She returned to her birthplace, remained with her grandmother and decided finally to return to **Castres**, when she was 19 years old. After many years, **Jeanne- Emilie** decided to join “**the Charity Sisters**”. She founded with two of her friends after having the blessing of the bishop, the **Order of the Immaculate Conception** on 8/1/ 1936. It was immediately known by “**the Blue Nuns**” according to their blue dress.

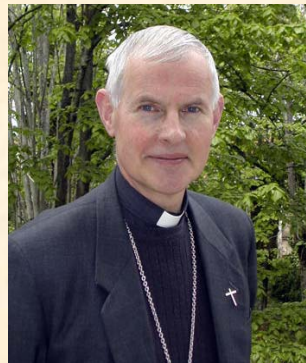
With her sisters, she took care of the lost young workers, sick, prisoners and girls. The Order grew and became known all over the world especially in **Africa**.

In 1853, **Sister Jeanne Emilie** died after she was attacked by cholera, when she was 42 years old.

The Catholic Church beatifies on **Sunday July 5<sup>th</sup> 2009** **Sister Emilie de Villeneuve** who founded the **Order of the Immaculate Conception** in her village of **Castres- France**.
